Our swimming pool is an important asset. Let's work together to keep it safe and secure!

- The Riviera West swimming pool is our joint property and responsibility. Misuse of the pool causes discord and has a negative impact on all members of the homeowners' association. The rules are in place for everyone's benefit. Please do your part to keep our pool safe and pleasant for all members.
- Pool rules will be monitored and enforced during the summer months of 2020. Avoid a fine or an embarrassing situation by following Riviera West pool rules.
- During routine monitoring, members must show their key card to authorized Riviera West representatives (office staff, board members or Pool Committee members).
- Do not loan your key card to others.
- Do not admit others to the pool, even if someone comes to the gate and asks to be admitted. Each group must have their own key card.
- Only six people can enter the gate on each key card at any one time.
- Teens and children under the age of 14 must be accompanied by an adult with an authorized Riviera West key card.
- The Riviera West pool is not a venue for a pool party. This type of use interferes with the peaceful enjoyment of the pool by others.
- Do not allow children or others to play on the ropes. The rope is an important safety feature and has repeatedly been damaged by unsupervised play.
- Please remove your trash when leaving the pool. There is no attendant to clean our pool area, so for the health and safety of everyone please clean up after yourselves.
- Remember you are liable for the behavior of guests you have admitted with your key card. Do not risk a fine or loss of pool privileges.
